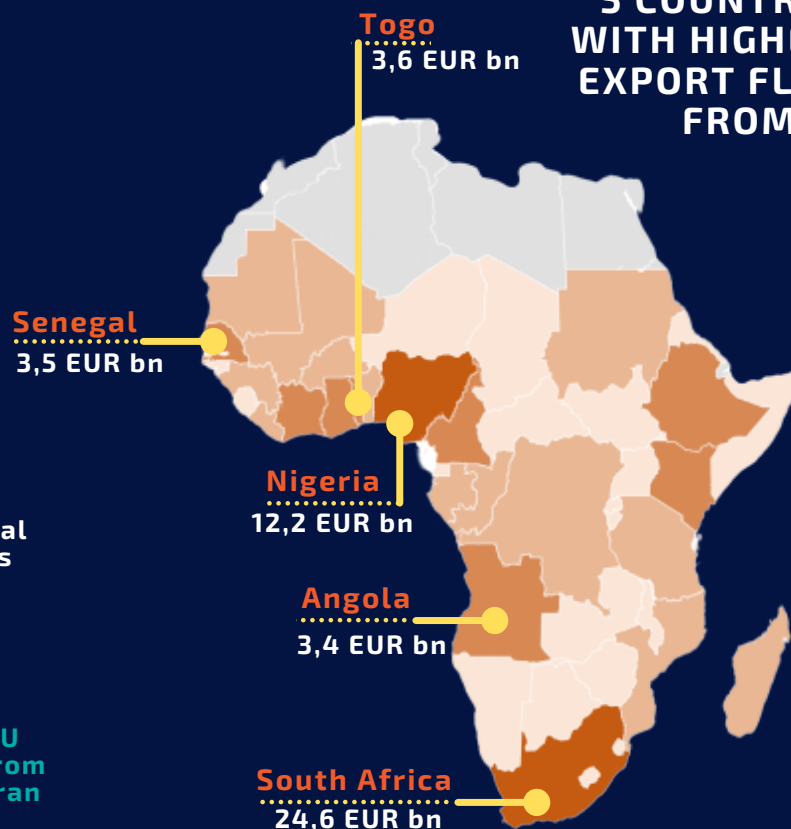
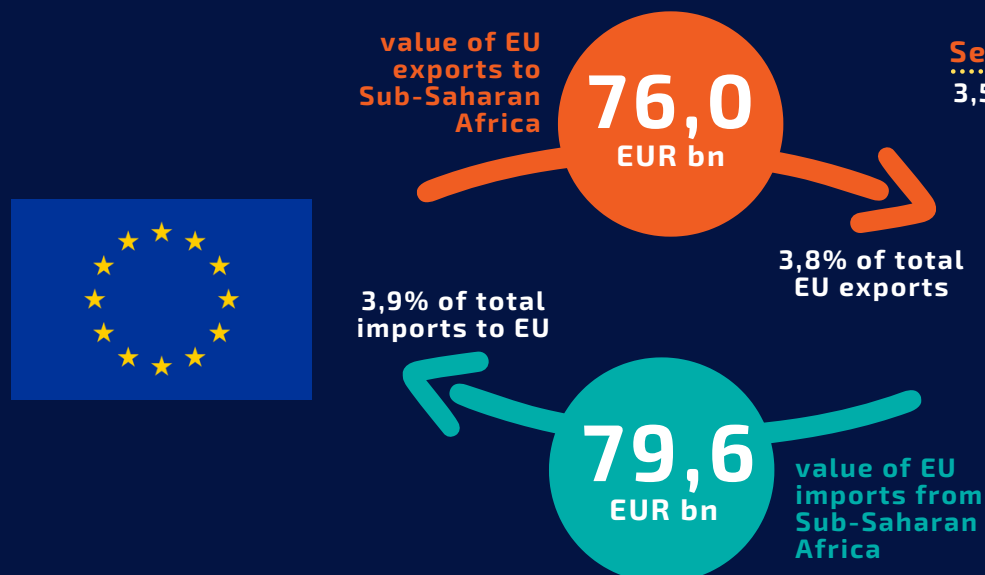


TRADE COOPERATION OF EUROPEAN UNION AND SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA

TRADE FLOWS BETWEEN EU AND SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA



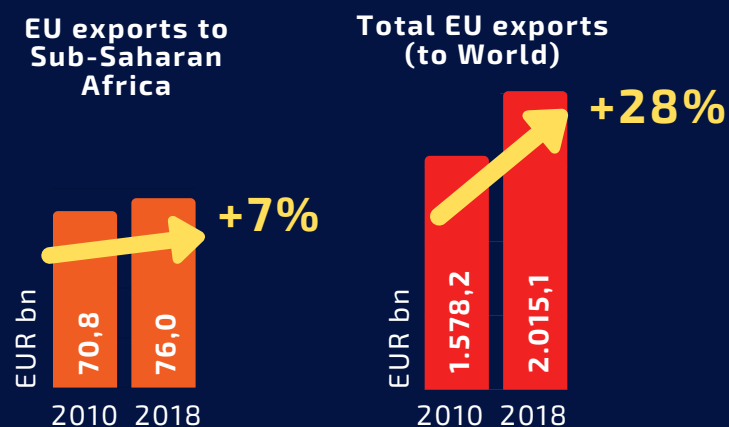
SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA

is a region of **48 countries** with more than one billion habitants and GDP growth of 2,4% in 2018 (source: The World Bank).

EUROPEAN UNION COOPERATION WITH AFRICAN COUNTRIES

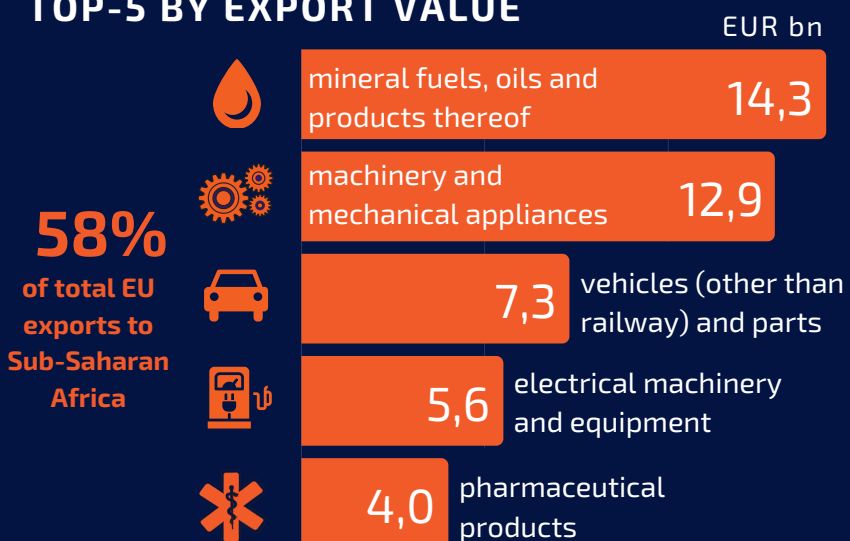
is regulated by the **Cotonou Agreement** (valid from 2000 and specifying the framework for EU relations with African, Caribbean and Pacific countries) and the **Joint Africa-EU Strategy** adopted in 2007 as the formal channel for EU relations with African countries. **Trade, development, security, migration and counter-terrorism** are the key areas of the EU-Africa cooperation. **Trade cooperation** with Sub-Saharan Africa is regulated by a series of economic partnership agreements (EPAs) that aim to create a shared trade and development partnership backed up by development support (source: The European Council).

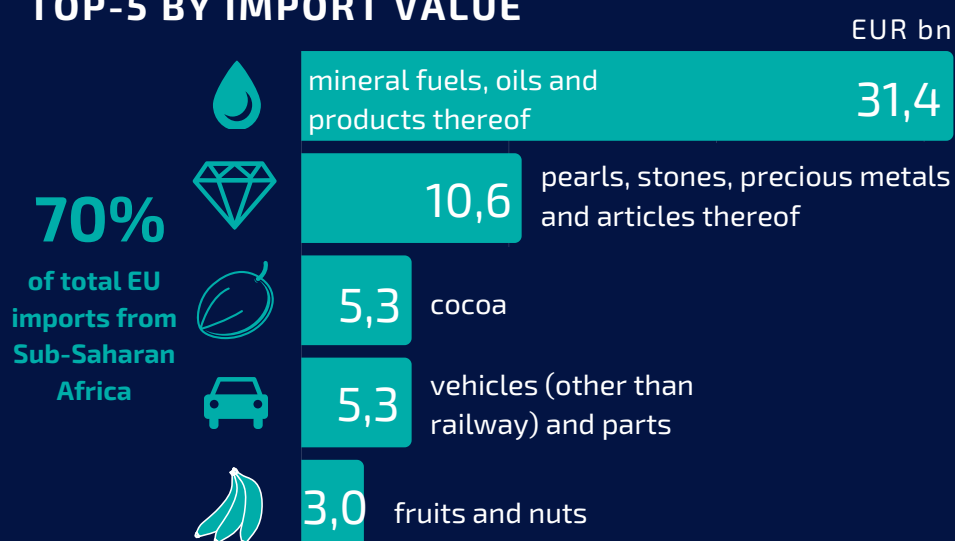
